

The Turning Point Counselling Service

Since 2002 The Turning Point Counselling Service has been committed to supporting individuals suffering from mental health and emotional difficulties within the local community. We endeavour to be accessible to all who approach us offering a compassionate service, tailored to an individual's need in an environment where mutual respect and courtesy are demonstrated by both counsellor and client. The Service is based in Church Lane close to the centre of Brighouse on the first floor of rented premises.



The number of counselling sessions supported is tailored to the needs of each individual. We accept self-referrals from clients over fourteen years of age and local GPs, Insight and other mental health services signpost potential clients to us. The Turning Point aims to offer counselling that enables clients suffering from mental illness, depression, or anxiety to develop coping strategies and skills enabling and empowering them to overcome their difficulties. We maintain a welcoming, non-judgemental, and non-discriminatory service to anyone seeking our support.

We offer telephone support to anyone who calls and contact calls to clients on our waiting list. We work with local Universities enabling trainee counsellors to gain their necessary training hours in a supportive and supervised environment which provides a pathway into the counselling profession.

The administrator position will be for twelve hours per week and will report to our counselling co-ordinator. The service currently operates Monday to Friday including some early evening appointments the hours can be worked flexibly but ideally over at least three days as this will maximise the cover in the office which is currently limited.
